#### Parental responsibilities:

- To be a partner with the school in the education of your children
- To understand and support the religious nature of the school
- To read all communications from the school
- To discuss concerns and problems with appropriate personnel
- To be as actively involved as you can be in the life of the school and to volunteer assistance when possible
- To meet your financial obligations in a timely manner and to support fundraising efforts.
- To read and support the school's parent-student handbook
- To broaden an interest in Catholic education and speak well of the school within the community
- To commit to available educational training sessions

## School rights:

- To have a safe environment for all
- To have all teachers and staff treated with respect by students and parents
- To create and maintain an environment conducive to learning
- To provide professional development training
- To determine parameters of the school curriculum set by diocesan standards
- To determine the appropriate use of school funds
- To determine eligibility for enrollment

### School responsibilities

- To provide a safe environment for everyone
- To hire qualified personnel
- To assess students' needs and help in their academic and spiritual development
- To treat all individuals with respect
